



eChalk Version 12.5 Enhancements & New Features

Announcement Archive Listing

- The new Announcement Archive listing will enable site visitors, and members of the school and district to view and search for expired announcements.
- To create the link to the Announcement Archive, a Site Manager/Site Administrator can copy the Announcement Archive link located at the top of the **Manage Site > Homepage > Announcements** page and paste it into any Rich Text Editor box. eChalk will automatically update the Archive page as announcements expire. See Figures 1 - 6 listed below for more details.

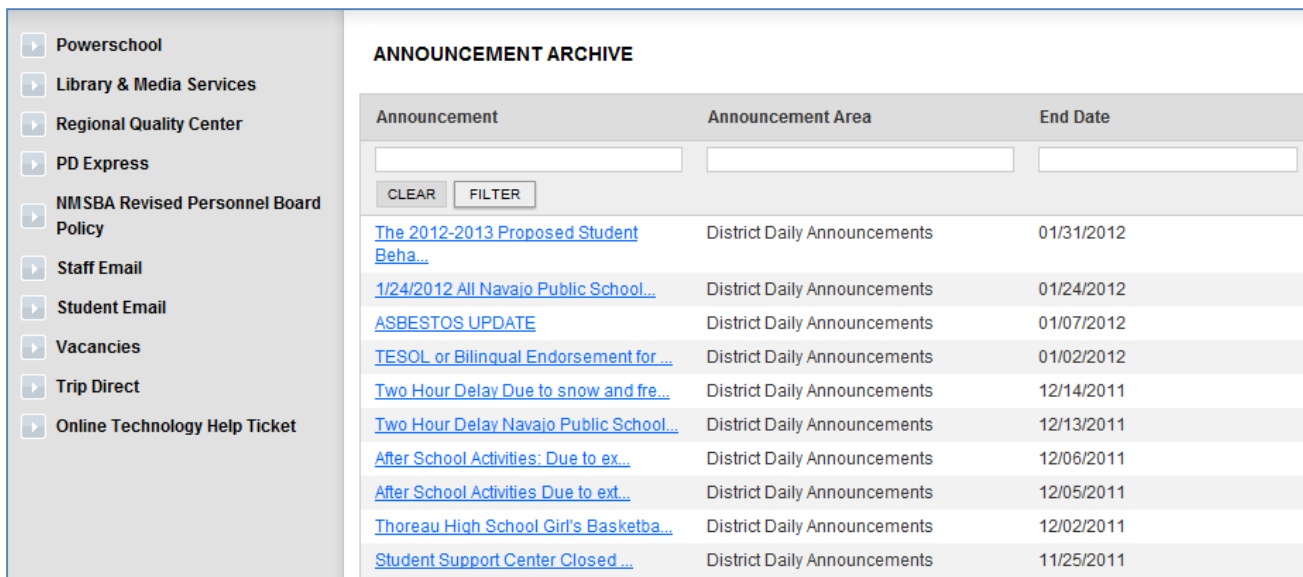


Figure 4 – Announcement Archive Listing

tip Add as a Navigation Link

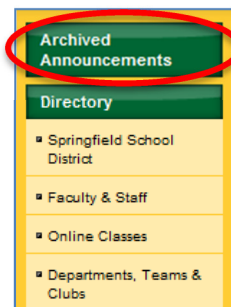


Figure 5 – Example Navigation Link

You may also add the Announcement Archive listing page as a navigation or resource link on your site under **Manage Site > Resources**. Use this format for the Web link: **http://SiteURL/archived_announcements.aspx**

Replace “SiteURL” with your school’s Web site address. This link will display properly on both public and private pages (My School / My District).

NOTE: Be sure to uncheck, or deselect, the “Open Link in a Separate Browser Window” option.

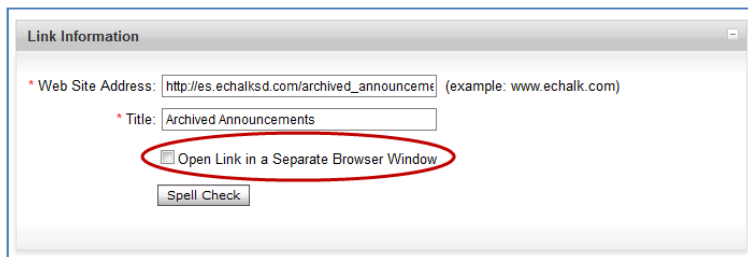


Figure 6 – Disable “Open Link in a Separate Browser Window” option.

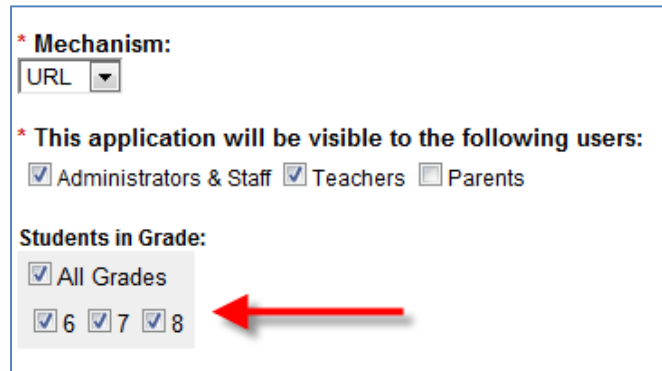


Figure 7 – 3rd Party Apps for Students by Grade(s)

- When viewing a message users can select **More Actions > Translate**, and translate their mail message into any of the supported 50+ languages.

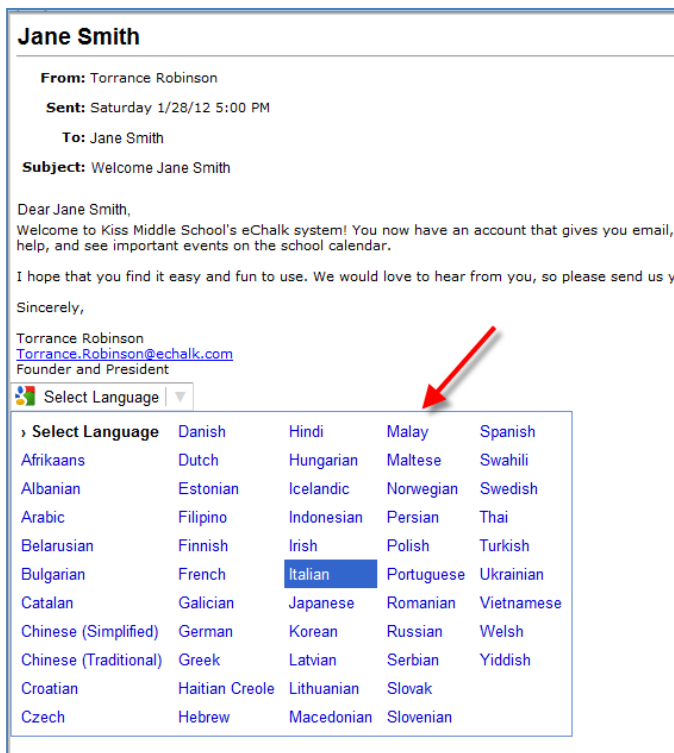
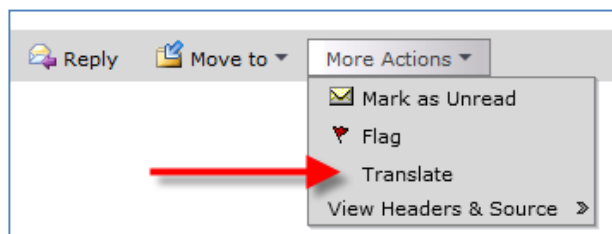


Figure 8 – Translate Ajax – Mail Message
